

COOKIE POLICY

To ensure the proper functioning of the websites managed by the Owners (i.e. Data CoLAB and NBI), we install small data files, so-called "cookies", on your device.

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, how we use them, what information we collect, how that information is subsequently used, and how you can control your cookie preferences.

1. Who are we?

2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small piece of data (text file) that a website - when visited by a User - asks your browser to store on your device to remember information about you, such as your language preference or login information.

3. How do we use cookies?

Our website uses cookies, defined by us, in order to ensure that the website works as well as possible.

Cookies do not collect any personally identifiable data.

4. Cookies we use and their purpose

a. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems.

They are usually only set up in response to actions taken by you that correspond to a request for services, such as setting your privacy preferences, logging in, or filling in forms.

You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of the website will not work.

These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information.

b. Preference cookies

Preference cookies allow a website to remember information that changes the behaviour or appearance of the website, such as your preferred language or the region you are in.

c. Statistical cookies

Statistical cookies help website owners understand how visitors interact with websites by collecting and disclosing information anonymously.

e. Third-party cookies

5. How to manage Cookies

You have the possibility at any time to configure your browser to reject some/all cookies, to be notified when a cookie is issued or not to receive any cookies at all. How you manage this depends on the web browser you use.
